### **The city of Isaccea implements the Project "CBCConnect Trans - Development of a cross-border intermodal connection between Isaccea-Orlivka-Tulcea-Izmail"**

Within the Joint Operational Program Romania - Ukraine 2014-2020, U.A.T. Isaccea, on 14.10.2022, the project partners together with the JTS project monitoring officers had a meeting according to the activity Project management and monitoring of project activities. The meeting took place at the headquarters of U.A.T. Isaccea.

The topics of discussion were: the actual state of implementation of each partner's objectives, designations of change project implementation teams, the preparation of the additional act with certain changes (budget savings, etc.), and future actions.

In November, the service contract for the creation of a capacity building program for the project is to be signed. Also, the contract for the provision of services for organizing conferences at the beginning and end of the project was signed.

The CBCConnect Trans project aims to strengthen the transport facilities in Tulcea counties (the modal transport section between the cities of Isaccea and Tulcea) and the Odessa region (the modal transport section between the city of Izmail and the town of Orlivka), by developing mobility systems dedicated to the population of the eligible area, by developing multimodal transport connections (road/water) and increasing the number of crossings through the Isaccea-Orlovka cross-border customs point, Investment Priority 3.1-Development of cross-border transport infrastructure, Thematic Objective 7-Improving accessibility to regions, development of networks and systems transport and communication.

Within the project, converging activities are expected to improve the road infrastructure and river transport facilities for passengers and goods in the Isaccea - Orlivka - Izmail area, complementary to the modernization of civil and commercial traffic monitoring systems at the border crossing points, respectively the promotion territorial cohesion between Tulcea county and Odessa region.

1. "Rehabilitation and modernization of 0.9 km of access road and installation of public road lighting";
2. "Rehabilitation of the wholesale market"
3. "Installation of the traffic monitoring system"
4. "Trans Hub Isaccea construction rehabilitation - modernization of the information center for transport".

Benefits to be obtained as a result of achieving the proposed objectives are the following:  
Improving the transport infrastructure;  
Increasing the accessibility of the population to efficient services in the border area, thus improving the standard of living;  
Efficient use and protection of shared natural resources;  
Use of common procedures and infrastructures;  
Effective management of wastewater, efficiency of wastewater treatment.
