The city of Isaccea implements the Project " CBCConnect Trans - Development of a cross-border intermodal connection between Isaccea-Orlivka-Tulcea-Izmail "

Within the framework of the Joint Operational Program Romania - Ukraine 2014-2020, UAT Isaccea participated on 10.07.2023 together with partner B3 (Executive Committee of the Izmail City Council) in the online meeting whose subject was the clarification of the minutes and future activities.

Within the project, the following objectives are expected:

1. "Rehabilitation and modernization of 0.9 km of access road and installation of public road lighting";
2. "Rehabilitation of the wholesale market"
3. "Installation of the traffic monitoring system"
4. "Trans Hub Isaccea construction rehabilitation - modernization of the information center for transport".

Within the ongoing objectives, 80% of the construction " Rehabilitation of the Trans Hub Isaccea building - modernization of the transport information center" is completed, "Installation of the traffic monitoring system" - 20%, "Rehabilitation of the wholesale market" - 10 %.

On 24.07.2023, the order was given to start the works on the investment objective "Rehabilitation and modernization of 0.9 km of access road and installation of public road lighting".

Benefits to be obtained as a result of achieving the proposed objectives are the following:

Improving the transport infrastructure;

Increasing the accessibility of the population to efficient services in the border area, thus improving the standard of living;

Efficient use and protection of shared natural resources;

Use of common procedures and infrastructures;

Effective management of wastewater, efficiency of wastewater treatment
