The city of Isaccea implements the Project " CBConnect Trans - Development of a cross-border intermodal connection between Isaccea-Orlivka-Tulcea-Izmail "

Within the Joint Operational Program Romania - Ukraine 2014-2020, U.A.T. The city of Isaccea participated on the dates of 20 - 21.11.2023 in the first meeting for the development of the cross-border Strategy in the field of transport, organized by the Executive Committee of the Izmail City Council, a meeting that took place with all project partners.

Following the notification received from the Joint Technical Secretariat - Regional Office for Transfrontier Cooperation Suceava and considering the good prospects of completing the infrastructure quota by the end of 2023 and the low level of risk, the amount of the grant can be increased for the Main Beneficiary - UAT Oras Isaccea with the maximum amount of EUR 166,486.25.

In November, the necessary documents for amending the budget were sent, so that the co-financing that had to be borne by UAT Oras Isaccea, is to be approved by an additional act, with the consent of the partners.

The stage of the works so far is as follows:

- Road – 75%
- Gross market - 70%
- Hub – 95%
- Monitoring system – up to 80%
