Work is underway on the definitive panels with the name of the project and their installation is to follow.

During the implementation, the budgets of all partners were modified through additional documents to the Financing Agreement in order to use the savings recorded and use the financial resources efficiently.

- Hub – 99%
- Gross market - 85%
- Monitoring system – up to 95%
- Road – 95%
